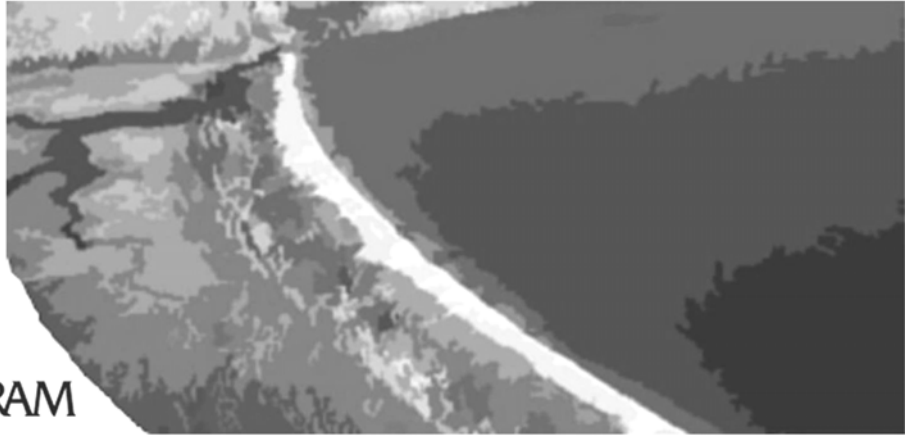


Great Lakes Coastal Wetlands: 10th Annual Wetland Science Forum

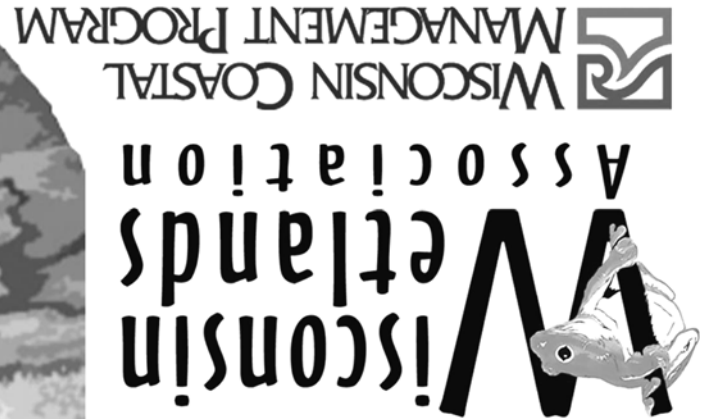
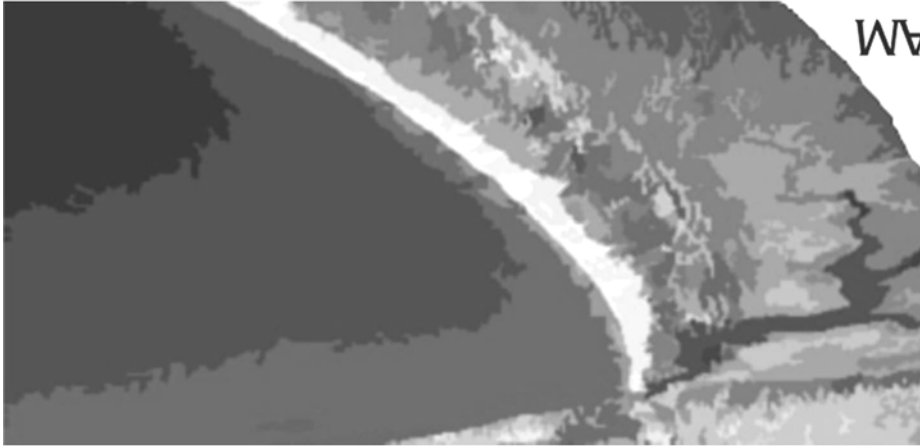
